On June 8, 1999, Enhanced Communications Network, Inc. (Applicant) of Hazlet, New Jersey, filed an application seeking authority to obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to transact the business of a reseller of interexchange telecommunications services and for approval of its initial tariff. Notice of application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 9, 1999.

O R D E R


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2062 be, and it is hereby, withdrawn without prejudice.


