BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed June 17, 1999, Teligent, Inc. (Teligent) of Vienna, Virginia, seeks pro forma assignment to Teligent Services, Inc. (TSI), of authority to operate as a local exchange and interexchange carrier of telecommunications in Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 18, 1999. Petitions for Formal Intervention were filed by Nebraska Independent Telephone Association, Consolidated Telephone Company, and Consolidated Telco, Inc. By stipulation entered into by all parties and filed with the Commission on August 10, 1999, the parties agreed to waive the holding of a public hearing in this application.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Teligent is a Delaware corporation that was granted authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services on January 27, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1714. Teligent was granted authority to operate as a local exchange carrier on April 14, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1715. TSI is a recently created Delaware corporation and has received authorization from the Secretary of State to conduct business in Nebraska.

As part of a broad corporate reorganization, Teligent created a wholly-owned subsidiary, TSI, to act as Teligent's operating company to provide telecommunications services. TSI will replace Teligent as the direct parent of several other domestic subsidiaries and as the certificated entity in Nebraska. In effect, TSI will be the same entity as Teligent. All Teligent employees will become employees of TSI. The restructuring will be transparent to customers and will not affect the quality of service currently received. Furthermore, the restructuring will not adversely affect the financial, technical, or managerial capabilities of Teligent or TSI. Teligent will also achieve many benefits as a result of the restructuring, such as increased financing flexibility and internal administrative savings.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the certificates granted in Docket Nos. C-1714 and C-1715 be, and they are hereby, revoked.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the reorganization within thirty days from the date of this order.
