BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 12, 1999, SeTel, L.L.C. (SeTel) of Nashville, Tennessee, seeks authority to cancel the company's certification to offer telecommunications services in Nebraska and to withdraw its tariff. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 17, 1999. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

On October 8, 1997, the Commission entered an order in Docket No. C-1550 granting SeTel, L.L.C. (SeTel) of Nashville, Tennessee, authority to operate as a resale common carrier of telecommunications services in the state of Nebraska.

SeTel requests that its certificate of operating authority be revoked and its tariff withdrawn. SeTel no longer offers service in Nebraska and does not have any customers in the state. In light of SeTel's self-initiated request, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously granted in Docket No. C-1550 to SeTel, L.L.C. be, and it is hereby, revoked.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff of SeTel, L.L.C. currently on file with the Commission be, and it is hereby, withdrawn.
