BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed September 13, 1999, PaeTec Communications, Inc. (Applicant) of Fairport, New York, seeks authority to amend its existing authority to include intrastate interexchange operator services in the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 17, 1999. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant received authority from this Commission to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services on March 16, 1999, pursuant to Application No. C-1991. A Commission grant of interexchange service authority only allows for the providing of operator services upon a subsequent application and approval by the Commission for such expansion of authority. Applicant desires to provide operator services to their customers and thus requests that their existing authority be expanded to include operator services.

From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds no basis for denying the applicant the authority to provide operator services in addition to the interexchange services already authorized. The applicant possesses adequate financial resources to provide the additional service and possesses adequate technical and managerial competency to provide operator services. The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2120 be, and it is hereby, granted and PaeTec Communications, Inc. is authorized to provide intrastate interexchange operator services in Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant amend its current tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the authority granted in this order.
