On September 16, 1999, an application was filed by Premiercom, Inc. (Applicant) of Elk Grove Village, Illinois, seeking authority to change its name to Opex Communications, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 17, 1999. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant received authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange interLATA and intraLATA telecommunications services in Nebraska from this Commission on November 24, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1911. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against applicant.

Applicant requests authority to change its name on its certificate of authority from Premiercom, Inc. to Opex Communications, Inc. The proposed name change will not affect the company's financial, technical or managerial capabilities. Applicant has received authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to use the name Opex Communications, Inc.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2121 be, and it is hereby, granted and Premiercom, Inc. is authorized to change its name to Opex Communications, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within thirty days from the date of this order.
