BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed September 23, 1999, CoreComm Limited, on behalf of USN Communications Long Distance, Inc. (USNC), both of Chicago, Illinois, seeks authority to voluntarily withdraw the Certificate of Fublic Convenience and Necessity for USN Communications Long Distance. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 24, 1999. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 19, 1999, USNC and CoreComm Limited executed an Asset Purchase Agreement under which CoreComm acquired substantially all of USNC's assets. Concurrently with execution of the Agreement, USNC filed voluntary petitions under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code. On April 2, 1999, the Bankruptcy Court approved USNC's motion for authorization of the proposed sale to CoreComm. Upon conclusion of the bankruptcy, USNC was dissolved and their assets were acquired by CoreComm.

USNC did not conduct operations in Nebraska, nor did it have any customers in the state. As such, CoreComm, on the behalf of USNC has requested the voluntary withdrawal of the USNC Certificate. In light of this request, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously

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granted in Docket No. C-1281, and modified in Docket No. C-1469, of USN Communications Long Distance be, and it is hereby, withdrawn.
