BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 30, 1999, an application was filed by Park 'N View, Inc. (Applicant) of Coral Springs, Florida, seeking authority to change its name to PNV.net, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 1, 1999. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant received authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska from this Commission on July 3, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1811. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against applicant.

Applicant requests authority to amend its certificate of authority to do business as PNV.net, Inc. The proposed name change will not affect the company's financial, technical or managerial capabilities. Applicant has received authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to use the name PNV.net, Inc.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2131 be, and it is hereby, granted and Park 'N View, Inc. is hereby authorized to change its name to PNV.net, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within thirty days from the date of this order.


