## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 20, 1999, an application was filed by Keith A. and Sarah A. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 22, 1999. A protest to the application was timely filed by Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company, of Jackson, Nebraska.
