On October 20, 1999, an application was filed by Keith A. and Sarah A. Strizek, of Valparaiso, who currently receive service from ALLTEL Communications, seeking authority to retain that telephone service from the Valparaiso exchange of ALLTEL Communications. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 22, 1999. A protest to the application was timely filed by Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company, of Jackson, Nebraska.

On January 13, 2000, the Commission received a letter from the applicants informing the Commission that they no longer wished to pursue their application and requesting that the application be dismissed. In light of the applicants' request, the Commission finds that the application should be dismissed.

O R D E R


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2142 be, and it is hereby, dismissed without prejudice.


