BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 5, 2000, the Commission entered an order in this docket making findings and conclusions and issuing, pursuant to those findings and conclusions, a series of orders. In examining the orders entered on that date, the Commission finds that two ordering clauses were included that are normally included with the granting of telecommunications authority by this Commission which are inapplicable in the instant case. This order corrects the record by:

- Deleting the sixth ordering clause, which ordered Citizens to "comply with Section 251 (f)(1)(b) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996" and to "submit any bona fide request(s) for interconnection, services or network elements from a rural telephone company to the Commission for approval." Such an ordering clause, we find, should not have been, and is not to be included, in this docket.
- Correcting the seventh ordering clause so that it now reads, "IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Citizens is obligated to abide by the same laws, rules and regulations, both federal and state, (including any laws, rules or regulations regarding universal service and quality of service) applicable to any other local exchange carrier."
- Deleting the twelfth ordering clause as being repetitive and possibly confusing. Therefore, the ordering clause which reads, "IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and hereby, is made the Commission's official certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Citizens to provide local exchange telecommunications services in (sic) throughout the state of Nebraska" is hereby deleted from that order.

Nothing in this order changes the Commission finding that it should approve acquisition from GTE Midwest Corp. of its Nebraska telephone exchanges and assets by Citizens.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that an Order Nunc Pro Tunc should be, and is hereby, made to correct the record in regard to the ordering clauses entered in
