BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 25, 2000, the Commission entered a pre-hearing conference order in this docket outlining the procedures for the hearing to be held on May 11, 2000. The Commission, pursuant to its Rules of Commission Procedure, finds that it should entertain additional testimony from its contract staff economist (see Title 291, Chapter 1, Rule 002.04).
