## BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 15, 1999, an application was filed by US West Communications of Denver, Colorado, seeking a declaration that competition exists for the exchanges in Omaha. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 17, 1999. Protests for formal intervention were filed by McLeodUSA Telecommunications, Cox Nebraska Telecom, L.L.C., Aliant Midwest Inc. and AT&T.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

This application was filed by US West Communications, asking for a declaration that competition exists for the exchanges in Omaha. On April 18, 2000, a pre-hearing conference was held at the Commission to discuss procedures relating to the May 11, 2000, hearing in this docket. Subsequently, an order was entered by the Commission on April 25, 2000, outlining the outcome of this discussion.

On May 2, 2000, a progression order was entered in this docket. Said order outlined further procedures for the May 11, 2000, hearing and found that the Commission should entertain additional staff testimony from its contract staff economist. Also, on May 2, 2000, the Commission entered a protective order for nondisclosure of confidential information provided by the parties in this docket.

On May 4, 2000, Progression Order No. 2 was entered in this docket. This order extended the deadline for pre-filed testimony to be accepted in this docket to May 12, 2000. In addition, the order continued the hearing to be held on May 11, 2000, to June 7, 2000.

On May 10, 2000, the Commission entered an order requesting data related to this docket. This data was ordered to be filed with the Commission no later that May 18, 2000. Finally, on June 7, 2000, the hearing in this docket was canceled.
