On November 15, 1999, an application was filed by Frontier Telemanagement, Inc. (Applicant) of Rochester, New York, seeking authority to change its name to Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 24, 1999. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant received authority to provide resold local exchange services within limited territories from this Commission on August 25, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1814. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against the applicant.

Applicant requests authority to change its name in Nebraska to Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc. The proposed name change will not affect the applicant's financial, technical, or managerial capabilities. Customers of the applicant have been notified of the proposed name change. Applicant has obtained authority from the Secretary of State to change its name to Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2159 be, and it is hereby, granted and Frontier Telemanagement, Inc. is authorized to change its name to Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within thirty days from the date of this order.


