On December 1, 1999, an application was filed by Allnet Communication Services, Inc., dba Frontier Communications Services (Applicant) of Rochester, New York, seeking authority to change its name to Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 2, 1999. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant received authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska from this Commission on August 1, 1989, pursuant to Application No. C-772. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against the applicant.

Applicant requests authority to change its name in Nebraska to Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. The proposed name change will not affect the applicant's financial, technical or managerial capabilities. Applicant has obtained authority from the Secretary of State to change its name to Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2170 be, and it is hereby, granted and Allnet Communication Services, Inc., dba Frontier Communications Services, is authorized to change its name to Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc.


