On December 15, 1999, an application was filed by Qwest Communications Corporation of Arlington, Virginia seeking authority to provide competitive resold and facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 16, 1999. Petitions for Formal Intervention were timely filed by Cox Nebraska Telcom, LLC; Arapahoe Telephone Company; Benkelman Telephone Company, Inc.; Cozad Telephone Company; Hemingford Cooperative Telephone Company; Henderson Cooperative Telephone Company; and Wauneta Telephone Company.

By letter dated March 14, 2000, Qwest requests that their application be withdrawn. The Commission is of the opinion that the applicant's request should be honored and the application should be withdrawn.
