O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On May 16, 2000, pursuant to Application No. C-2183, NorthPoint Communications, Inc. (NorthPoint) of San Francisco, California, was granted authority to provide local exchange telecommunications service within limited territories in Nebraska, and was granted authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services throughout Nebraska.

NorthPoint, in a letter dated March 23, 2001, has notified the Commission that following its filing of bankruptcy, NorthPoint is currently in the process of disconnecting customers and discontinuing all operations. NorthPoint requests that any grant of operating authority be canceled and that all tariffs be withdrawn. The Commission is of the opinion that NorthPoint's request should be honored and their certificate be canceled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-2183 to NorthPoint Communications, Inc. be, and it is hereby, canceled.
