On January 13, 1999, pursuant to Application No. C-2188, Blue Star Networks, Inc. of Nashville, Tennessee, was granted authority to obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide local exchange, exchange access and interexchange telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

By letter dated June 4, 2001, Blue Star has requested that its certificate be canceled. Blue Star has not provided any services within the state of Nebraska in the year 2000; therefore, no customers would be impacted by the withdrawal.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall become effective on June 19, 2001.
