OPINION AND FINDINGS

On January 3, 2001, an application was filed by Gary and Stanley Snyder of McCook, Nebraska, currently receiving service from the Maywood exchange of Consolidated Telco, Inc. (Consolidated), seeking authority to obtain telephone service from the McCook exchange of US West Communications, Inc. (n/k/a Qwest) through a boundary exchange. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 4, 2000.

After the filing of the application, the Commission contacted the companies in question and Consolidated consented to a boundary change for a fee of \$423.94 for loss of investment. Furthermore, Qwest was willing to build facilities on the applicant's property at a cost of \$8,700.00. Upon relating this information to the applicant, no action has been taken on their part. On August 29, 2001, a letter was sent by first class mail by the Commission, informing the applicant that unless informed otherwise, their application would be dismissed on September 19, 2001. There has been no response by the applicant and it is the opinion of this Commission that the above application should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2194 be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
