On January 31, 2000, an application was filed by Destia Communications Services, Inc. (Destia) of Brooklyn, New York, seeking authority to change the name on its certificate to Viatel Services, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 2, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Destia, formerly known as Econophone, Inc., received authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska from this Commission on October 8, 1996, pursuant to Application No. C-1362. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against the applicant.

Destia requests authority to change its name in Nebraska to Viatel Services, Inc. The proposed name change will not affect the applicant's financial, technical or managerial capabilities, nor will Destia's customers suffer any inconvenience as a result of the name change. Destia has obtained authority from the Secretary of State to change its name to Viatel Services, Inc.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2213 be, and it is hereby, granted and Destia Communications Services, Inc. is authorized to change its name to Viatel Services, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Destia file its amended tariff reflecting the proposed name change within thirty days of the date of this order.
