BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 16, 2000, an application was filed by Feist Long Distance Service, Inc. (Applicant or Feist) of Wichita, Kansas, seeking authority to change its name to Ionex Communications, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 21, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The applicant is a Kansas corporation and a subsidiary of Ionex Telecommunications, Inc. of Dallas, Texas. The Commission approved the transfer of Feist to Ionex Telecommunications, Inc. on October 19, 1999, pursuant to Application No. C-2095. Ionex Telecommunications, Inc. is not a certificated provider of telecommunications services in Nebraska. Feist received authority from this Commission to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska on May 4, 1993, pursuant to Application No. C-970. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against applicant.

Applicant requests authority to amend its certificate of authority to do business as Ionex Communications, Inc. The proposed name change will not affect the company's financial, technical or managerial capabilities. Applicant has received authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to use the name Ionex Communications, Inc.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2224 be, and it is hereby, granted and Feist Long Distance Service, Inc. is hereby authorized to change its name to Ionex Communications, Inc.
