By application filed March 23, 2000, Concentric Carrier Services, Inc. (Concentric) of San Jose, California, seeks authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 24, 2000.

On May 9, 2000, Concentric filed a motion requesting that the Commission withdraw the application without prejudice.
