By application filed March 23, 2000, Concentric Carrier Services, Inc. (Concentric) of San Jose, California, seeks authority to obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide resold and facilities-based, switched and dedicated, local exchange and exchange access telecommunications services. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 24, 2000.

On May 9, 2000, Concentric filed a motion requesting that the Commission withdraw the application without prejudice. Pursuant to Rule 008 of the Rules of Commission Procedure, Title 291, Chapter 1, pleadings filed with the Commission will not be withdrawn without Commission approval. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2253 be, and it is hereby, withdrawn without prejudice.






