## BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 17, 2000, One Tel Inc. of Long Beach, California, seeks authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 20, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

One Tel is a privately-held Delaware corporation with its principal offices located in Long Beach, California. One Tel has been authorized by the Secretary of State to transact business in the state of Nebraska.

One Tel is a switchless reseller of interexchange dial around (or 101XXXX) service for the transmission and reception of voice, data and other types of telecommunications. One Tel proposes to offer these services throughout the entire state of Nebraska. As One Tel does not currently and has no intention of owning facilities, service will be provided using the existing facilities of One Tel's underlying carriers. Customers will access One Tel's services by dialing One Tel's 101XXXX access code. Customer service will be available through a toll-free number, in English and Spanish, during regular business hours.

One Tel has been authorized to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service in California, Colorado, Illinois and Texas, and intends to seek certification throughout the country. In no instance has an application been denied by any state. Despite operating exclusively as a reseller and thus relying on the technical abilities of its underlying carriers, the One Tel management team possesses extensive telecommunications experience in its own right through their involvement in One Tel Limited, a company which provides telecommunications service to more than 340,000 customers worldwide.

Interexchange reseller applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-604 and 86-805 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds the applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service and possesses adequate technical

competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2273 be, and it is hereby, granted and One Tel Inc. is authorized to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall file, in accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting of: (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission, (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders and (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission. If these are not available, applicant shall submit a balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation, as well as the investment made in telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues and expenses and taxes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent applicable, the applicant shall comply with all laws pertaining to, and all rules and regulations promulgated under, the Telecommunications Relay System Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-1302 to 86-1307) and the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-1402 to 86-1410).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file its current tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.
