On July 6, 1995, pursuant to Application No. C-1138, Continental Long Distance Company (Continental) of Omaha was granted authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in Nebraska.

On May 1, 2000, the Commission was notified of Continental's request to have its certificate canceled. Continental does not currently conduct business in Nebraska; therefore, no customers will be inconvenienced by the cancellation of Continental's certificate. The Commission is of the opinion that Continental's request should be honored and its certificate should be canceled.



O R D E R
