On May 31, 2000, an application was filed by Houlton Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a EZ Phone Connections (Houlton) of Omaha, seeking authority to amend its certificate of authority to use the trade name of Guaranteed Phone Service. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 2, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

The applicant was authorized by this Commission to operate as a competitive local exchange carrier within limited territories in Nebraska pursuant to Application Nos. C-1782 and C-1963.

Houlton currently seeks to provide service in Nebraska under the trade name Guaranteed Phone Service. The addition of the new trade name will have no impact on the financial, managerial or technical capabilities of the company. Houlton has received authorization from the Secretary of State to use the trade name Guaranteed Phone Service.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2309 be, and it is hereby, granted and Houlton Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a EZ Phone Connections is authorized to use the trade name Guaranteed Phone Service.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
