BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 6, 2000, an application was filed by Southwestern Bell Communications Services, Inc., d/b/a Southwestern Bell Long Distance, d/b/a Nevada Bell Long Distance, d/b/a Pacific Bell Long Distance (SBCS) of Pleasanton, California, seeking approval to do business in Nebraska as SBC Long Distance. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 7, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application if processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

SBCS was authorized by this Commission on July 28, 1997, to operate as a resale common carrier of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska (see Application No. C-1554). On July 21, 1998, SBCS's application to use the trade names Nevada Bell Long Distance and Pacific Bell Long Distance was approved (see Application No. C-1827).

SBCS currently seeks to add an additional trade name, SBC Long Distance, for operations in Nebraska. SBCS has received authorization from the Secretary of State to use the name SBC Long Distance in Nebraska. The addition of a new trade name will not adversely affect SBCS's technical, managerial or financial capabilities and no terms, rates or conditions of SBCS's tariff will be affected. As SBCS does not currently have any customers in Nebraska, no customer notice is required.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2313 be, and it is hereby, granted and Southwestern Bell Communications Services, Inc., d/b/a Southwestern Bell Long Distance, d/b/a Nevada Bell Long Distance and d/b/a Pacific Bell Long Distance is authorized to do business in Nebraska as SBC Long Distance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
