O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On July 18, 2000, pursuant to Application No. C-2315, WorkNet Communications, Inc. (WorkNet) of St. Louis, Missouri, was granted authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in Nebraska. WorkNet is not certificated to provide local exchange services in Nebraska; an application requesting such authority was dismissed on March 20, 2001 (see Application No. C-2316).

On March 19, 2001, the Commission received a letter from WorkNet requesting that their certificates to provide intrastate local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services be canceled. WorkNet does not currently have any customers in Nebraska; therefore, no customer notice is required. The Commission is of the opinion that WorkNet's request should be honored and its certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications services should be canceled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-2315 to WorkNet Communications, Inc. be, and it is hereby, canceled.
