OPINION AND FINDINGS

On June 7, 2000, an application was filed by WorkNet Communications, Inc. (WorkNet) of St. Louis, Missouri, seeking authority to obtain a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide resold and facilities-based, switched and dedicated, local exchange and exchange access telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 8, 2000. Interventions were timely-filed by Arapahoe Telephone Company, Benkelman Telephone Company, Cozad Telephone Company, Henderson Cooperative Telephone Company and Wauneta Telephone Company.

Following the filing of this application, a hearing, to be conducted via video conference, was set for September 26, 2000, in the Commission Library. At WorkNet's request, the hearing was later postponed until such further time WorkNet desired to proceed with its application.

Today, more than nine months following the filing of its application, the Commission has yet to receive any indication from WorkNet when, or even if, it intends to proceed with its application. The docket of this Commission is not intended to be a repository of dormant applications, festering due to the lack of prosecution by the applicant. Accordingly, the application filed by WorkNet should be dismissed.
