On July 3, 2000, an application was filed by NYNEX Long Distance Company, d/b/a Bell Atlantic Business Services (Applicant) of Arlington, Virginia, seeking authority to change its name to NYNEX Long Distance Company, d/b/a Verizon Enterprise Solutions. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 5, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant received authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska from this Commission on September 24, 1996, pursuant to Application No. C-1368. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against the applicant.

Applicant requests authority to change its trade name in Nebraska to Verizon Enterprise Solutions. The proposed name change will not affect the applicant's financial, technical or managerial capabilities. Applicant has obtained authority from the Secretary of State to change its trade name to Verizon Enterprise Solutions.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.


