BY THE COMMISSION:

As a consequence of our investigation in the matter of C-2244, the Commission discovered that a boundary clarification is required between US West and Three River Telco in the Meadville, Nebraska area. Specifically, the boundary maps currently on file with the Commission delineating the service area boundaries between the two companies do not accurately reflect that two customers in the Meadville area of the Springview exchange currently receive service from the Ainsworth exchange served by US West. These customers are in the Three River Telco service area, but are provided telephone service by US West. The Commission finds that this docket should be opened to correct and clarify the boundaries between US West and Three River Telco.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2341 be, and it is hereby, opened for the purpose of clarifying the service area boundaries between US West and Three River Telco in the Meadville area and to grandfather service to the customers in the Three River Telco service area who are provided service by US West.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that US West and Three River Telco within thirty days of the entry of this order furnish this Commission with proposed revised exchange maps which reflect the grand-fathered customers of US West in the Three River Telco service area.
