On July 11, 2000, an application was filed by US West Communications, Inc. of Denver, Colorado, seeking authority to change its name to Qwest Corporation. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 12, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On June 30, 2000, the merger of Qwest Communications International Inc. and US West was consummated. This merger was the subject of a Commission investigation into the Commission's jurisdiction and the impact of the merger on Nebraska customers (see Docket No. C-2137/PI-32).

Following consummation of the merger, US West requests to change its name to Qwest Corporation. The proposed name change will not affect the financial, managerial or technical capabilities of the company. US West has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the name Qwest Corporation.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2344 be, and it is hereby, granted and US West Communications, Inc. is authorized to change its name to Qwest Corporation.
