O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On July 24, 2000, a joint application was filed by Integra Telecom of Nebraska, Inc. of Beaverton, Oregon, and US West Communications, Inc. of Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of the third amendment to their interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 26, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Integra and US West entered into an interconnection agreement, which was approved by the Commission on April 5, 2000, in Application No. C-2250. In the current application, Integra and US West seek to amend the original agreement by replacing language regarding unbundled dedicated interoffice transport. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed July 24, 2000, should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the third amendment to the interconnection agreement between Integra Telecom of Nebraska, Inc. and US West Communications, Inc. be, and it is hereby, approved.

is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
