## BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 9, 2000, an application was filed by GTE Communications Corporation of Irving, Texas, seeking authority to change its name to Verizon Select Services, Inc. Notice of the application was published in <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/jheps.com/">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 10, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

The applicant was originally authorized by this Commission to operate as a resale carrier of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska on August 14, 1995, pursuant to Application No. C-1191.

Resulting from the merger of GTE and Bell Atlantic, forming Verizon Communications, the applicant currently seeks to change its name in Nebraska to Verizon Select Services, Inc. The applicant has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. In addition, the name change will not adversely affect the company's significant financial, technical or managerial capabilities.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2365 be, and it is hereby, granted and GTE Communications Corporation is authorized to change its name to Verizon Select Services, Inc.
