By application filed August 16, 2000, Sigma Networks Telecommunications, Inc. (Sigma or Applicant) of San Jose, California, seeks authority to obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide resold and facilities-based, dedicated and private line local exchange telecommunications service. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 17, 2001. A petition of formal intervention was timely filed on behalf of Arapahoe Telephone Company, Benkelman Telephone Company, Cozad Telephone Company, Henderson Cooperative Telephone Company and Wauneta Telephone Company by their attorney, Tim Clare.

On May 14, 2001, the applicant requested permission to withdraw its application without prejudice. Upon consideration of the applicant's request, we find that the above-captioned application should be dismissed without prejudice.
