BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 24, 2000, an application was filed by Frontier Communications International, Inc. (Applicant) of Rochester, New York, seeking authority to change its name to Global Crossing North American Networks, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on August 28, 2000. No protests were filed, therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

RCI Long Distance, Inc. was granted authority to provide intrastate interLATA and intraLATA interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska pursuant to Application No. C-1066 on July 19, 1994. In Application No. C-1139 and on January 31, 1995, this Commission entered an order approving RCI Long Distance, Inc.'s request to change its name to Frontier Communications International, Inc. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against the applicant.

Applicant requests the authority to change its corporate name in Nebraska to Global Crossing North American Networks, Inc. The proposed name change will not affect the company's management, ownership, quality of service or rates. Customers have been notified through an announcement printed in each customer's bill and also through a national advertising campaign. Applicant has obtained authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to change its corporate name to Global Crossing North American Networks, Inc.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days from the date of this order.


