On September 18, 2000, an application was filed by Computer Business Sciences, Inc. (Applicant) of Kew Gardens, New York, seeking approval to change its name to IG2, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 19, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

Applicant was authorized to provide local exchange and intra-state interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska on November 4, 1999, pursuant to Application No. C-2075. Applicant is also authorized by the FCC to provide international telecommunications services, and is authorized to provide telecommunications services in 31 jurisdictions in the United States, including Nebraska.

Applicant seeks to change its name to IG2, Inc. The name change will not inconvenience customers, who will be notified of the name change through bill inserts or other appropriate methods. The name change will not affect applicant's managerial, technical or financial capabilities. Applicant has received authority from the Secretary of State to change its name to IG2, Inc.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2390 be, and it is hereby, granted
