Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 28, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

Cox, an authorized provider of both local exchange and inter-exchange telecommunications services in Nebraska, seeks to use the trade name Cox Business Services in Nebraska. The addition of the new trade name will have no impact on the financial, managerial or technical capabilities of the company. Cox has received authorization from the Secretary of State to adopt the trade name Cox Business Services. Current customers will be notified of the new name via bill inserts and bill messages, and Cox Business Services will be marketed to new customers through the use of direct mailing and direct contact by Cox's sales team.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2393 be, and it is hereby, granted and Cox Nebraska Telcom, L.L.C. is authorized to use the trade name Cox Business Services.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.


