On November 21, 2000, in Application No. C-2402, Congee Communications Corporation, d/b/a CommRad.com (CommRad) was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interLATA and intraLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

By letter dated March 5, 2001, CommRad requests that their certificate of public convenience and necessity be canceled and their tariff be withdrawn. As CommRad does not currently provide service to any customers in Nebraska, no customer notice is required. In light of CommRad's request, the Commission is of the opinion that the CommRad's certificate should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously granted to Congee Communications Corporation, d/b/a CommRad.com in Application No. C-2402 be, and it is hereby, canceled.
