BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed November 27, 2000, Bradley and Susan Jepsen of Kenesaw, who currently reside within the Kenesaw exchange of ALLTEL Communications (ALLTEL), seek authority to receive telephone service from the Shelton exchange of the Nebraska Central Telephone Company (NCTC). Notice of the application was published in <u>The Daily Record</u>, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 1, 2000.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

ALLTEL and NCTC are local exchange carriers holding certificates of public convenience and necessity to provide local exchange service in their respective territories. The Jepsens, who conduct business in and have greater ties to Shelton, request a boundary change so that they may receive local exchange service from NCTC's Shelton exchange rather than ALLTEL's Kenesaw exchange. NCTC has indicated that it is able to provide service to the Jepsens, and ALLTEL has acquiesced to a release of the Jepsen's to NCTC at no cost to the Jepsens.

Changes of a local exchange territory are governed by Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-612 to 75-615. Section 75-612 states that only upon non-consent by all telephone carriers involved shall the Commission hold a public hearing in the application. With no protest filed by any party and with each of the affected local exchange carriers consenting to the boundary change, the Commission processes this application administratively and without a public hearing.

The Commission finds that, in light of the agreement among all parties involved, the application is in the public interest and should be granted.
