On November 27, 2000, an application was filed by TotalTel, Inc. (TotalTel) of Little Falls, New Jersey, seeking authority to change the name of its operating authority to Covista, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 1, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

TotalTel, formerly known as TotalTel USA Communications, Inc., was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska on December 6, 1994, pursuant to Application No. C-1098.

Due to business considerations, TotalTel seeks to change the name under which it operates in Nebraska to Covista, Inc. The proposed name change will not affect the financial, managerial or technical capabilities of the company. TotalTel has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the name Covista, Inc.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2434 be, and it is hereby, granted and TotalTel, Inc. is authorized to change its name to Covista, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
