OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed December 8, 2000, CommChoice of Iowa, L.L.C. (CommChoice) of North Sioux City, South Dakota, seeks authority to obtain a certificate of authority to provide local exchange telecommunications services as a competitive local exchange carrier in the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in <u>The Daily Record</u>, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 11, 2000.

Per conversations with Commission staff regarding their application, CommChoice has indicated that they will be unable to cure the deficiencies of the application, most notably the absence of a sample tariff, for the foreseeable future. In light of the lengthy delay involved with the processing of the application, CommChoice has consented to a dismissal of the application while the company makes such business decisions that would allow it to file an up-to-date and complete application as required by our rules. Accordingly, the Commission is of the opinion that the current application should be dismissed without prejudice.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2448 be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
