BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 11, 2000, an application was filed by Gateway Technologies, Inc. (Gateway) of Carrollton, Texas, seeking authority to change its name to T-NETIX Telecommunications Services, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 13, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

Gateway was authorized by this Commission on September 17, 1996 to operate as a resale common carrier of intrastate inter-exchange telecommunications services in Nebraska (see Application No. C-1353). On October 5, 1999, the Commission approved the transfer of control of Gateway to T-NETIX, Inc. (see Application No. C-2080).

Gateway currently seeks to change its name to T-NETIX Telecommunications Services, Inc. Gateway has received authorization from the Secretary of State to use the name T-NETIX Telecommunications Services, Inc. in Nebraska. The addition of a new trade name will not adversely affect Gateway's technical, managerial or financial capabilities.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2450 be, and it is hereby, granted and Gateway Technologies, Inc. is authorized to change its name to T-NETIX Telecommunications Services, Inc.



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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
