O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On December 11, 2000, a joint application was filed by New Edge Network, Inc., d/b/a New Edge Networks (New Edge) of Vancouver, Washington, and Qwest Corporation, f/k/a US West Communications, Inc. of Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of Amendment No. 1 to their existing interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 13, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On January 4, 2000, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest (then known as US West) and New Edge was approved by the Commission (see Application No. C-2165). In the current application, New Edge and Qwest seek to amend certain terms of the original agreement. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed by New Edge and Qwest should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Amendment No. 1 to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation, f/k/a US West Communications, Inc. and New Edge Network, Inc., d/b/a New Edge Networks be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
