OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 6, 2001, the Commission approved a volutarily-negotiated interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation f/k/a US West Communications, Inc. and Premiere Network Services, Inc. Premiere Network Services, Inc. is a certificated local exchange carrier in Nebraska (see Application No. C-2386). After issuing the order, the Commission discovered that the interconnection agreement submitted for approval was between Qwest and Premier Communications Group, a Delaware corporation that is not certificated in Nebraska.

The purpose of an order nunc pro tunc is to correct the record which has been made so that it will truly record the action taken which, through inadvertence or mistake, was not truly recorded. *Interstate Printing Co. v. Dept. of Revenue*, 236 Neb. 110, 459 N.W.2d 519 (1990). Clerical errors may be corrected by an order nunc pro tunc, but not judicial errors. *Larson v. Redke*, 211 Neb. 247, 318 N.W.2d 253 (1982).

After examining the record and being fully advised, the Commission finds that the February 6, 2001, order in this docket should be corrected to reflect the true parties to the approved interconnection agreement: Qwest and Premier Communications Group. The Commission notes that despite the existence of a Commission-approved interconnection agreement with Qwest, Premier Communications Group does not possess a certificate of operating authority from this Commission and, therefore, is prohibited from providing telecommunications services in Nebraska until an application for such authority is filed with and approved by this Commission.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Commission's February 6, 2001, order in this docket be, and it

is hereby, corrected to reflect the status of Premier Communications Group as party to the approved interconnection agreement with Qwest Corporation.
