On February 2, 2001, an application was filed by NOS Communications, Inc. (NOS) of Las Vegas, Nevada, seeking authority to add the following d/b/a names: INETBA, iVANTAGE NETWORK SOLUTIONS and 011 Communications. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 5, 2001. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

NOS was authorized to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange interLATA and intraLATA telecommunications services on June 9, 1992, pursuant to Application No. C-920. On August 17, 1999, the Commission authorized NOS's addition of the d/b/a International Plus (see Application No. C-2058).

In the present application, NOS seeks authorization to use three additional trade names: INETBA, iVANTAGE NETWORK SOLUTIONS, 011 Communications. NOS has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new trade names. The addition of the new trade names will have no effect on the financial, technical or managerial qualifications of NOS. As NOS intends to file a stand-alone tariff under the each new name, there will be no effect on current customers of NOS. Based on the all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2481 be, and it is hereby, granted and NOS Communications, Inc. is authorized to do business as: INETBA, iVANTAGE NETWORK SOLUTIONS, and 011 Communications.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.





