BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 2, 2001, an application was filed by Affinity Network Incorporated (Affinity) of Las Vegas, Nevada, seeking authority to use the d/b/a HorizonOne Communications. Notice of the application was published in <u>The Daily Record</u>, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 5, 2001. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Affinity was authorized to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interLATA and intraLATA telecommunications services on December 10, 1991, pursuant to Application No. C-897. On August 3, 1999, the Commission authorized Affinity's addition of the d/b/a QuantumLink Communications (see Application No. C-2019).

In the present application, Affinity seeks authorization to use the trade name HorizonOne Communications. Affinity has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new trade name. The addition of the d/b/a HorizonOne Communications will have no effect on the financial, technical or managerial qualifications of Affinity. As Affinity intends to file a stand-alone tariff under the new name, there will be no effect on current customers of Affinity. Based on the all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2482 be, and it is hereby, granted and Affinity Network Incorporated is authorized to do business as HorizonOne Communications.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
