OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 23, 2001, a joint application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, and Sprint Communications Company, L.P. (Sprint) of Overland Park, Kansas, seeking approval of 911/waiver amendment to their interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 27, 2001. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On August 26, 1997, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest (then known as US West) and Sprint was approved by this Commission, pursuant to Application No. C-1417. The original agreement was subsequently amended pursuant to orders entered in Docket Nos. C-2452, C-2473, and C-2474. In the present application, Sprint and Qwest seek to once again amend their agreement. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the 911/waiver amendment to the interconnection agreement between

Qwest Corporation and Sprint Communications Company, L.P. be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
