OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 14, 2001, a joint application was filed by Citizens Telecommunications Company of Nebraska (Citizens) of Mound, Minnesota, and Community Internet Systems, Inc. (CIS) of Columbus, seeking approval of Amendment No. 1 to their interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 16, 2001. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On December 12, 2000, the original interconnection agreement between Citizens and CIS was approved by this Commission, pursuant to Application No. C-2425. In the current application, Citizens and CIS seek to amend their agreement with Amendment No. 1. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Amendment No. 1 to the interconnection agreement between Citizens Telecommunications Company of Nebraska and Community Internet Systems, Inc. be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
