BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 20, 2001, representatives from the Nebraska State Patrol and the Nebraska Department of Roads presented to the Commission a proposal to create an Advanced Traveler Weather Information System (ATWIS).

ATWIS would provide route-specific weather forecasts and road condition reports to callers based upon specific location information provided by the caller. This constantly updated information should result in safer and more efficient travel throughout Nebraska. The proposed system would be reached by individuals in Nebraska by dialing "511" a statewide three digit number.

On May 2, 2001, the Commission held a workshop and a public hearing in this matter. Based on the information received at those forums, the Commission finds:

- 1. The NXX three digit dialing code of "511" should be reserved and designated as the number for the ATWIS system.
- 2. The Department of Roads and the Nebraska State Patrol will move forward to deploy the ATWIS system.
- 3. The Commission will schedule a workshop on August 15, 2001 to address further implementation issues and develop an implementation schedule.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that 511 be and it is hereby designated for access to ATWIS.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a workshop be scheduled for August 15, 2001, at 1:30 p.m. CDT in the Commission Hearing Room, to address further implementation issues and develop an implementation schedule.
