O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

On March 29, 2001, a joint application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, and Wireless II, d/b/a Nebraska Wireless (Wireless II) of Grand Island, seeking approval of the First Amendment to their Type II Wireless Interconnection Agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 2, 2001. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On October 7, 1998, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest (then known as US West) and Wireless II was approved by this Commission, pursuant to Application No. C-1902. In the present application, Wireless II and Qwest seek to amend their agreement. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and Wireless II, d/b/a Nebraska Wireless be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
